information concerning the subject matter of this lawsuit to anyone except the counsel of record, the named parties, and the court personnel. This Motion is supported by the following Memorandum of Points and Authorities, attached exhibits, and the Court's file.

MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

I. <u>BACKGROUND</u>

Since filing a string of lawsuits that began in May 2010, Mr. Victor has engaged in media pandering in this case which, whether intended or not, has the effect of prejudicing Defendants through extrajudicial statements that undermine Defendants' right to a fair trial. On multiple occasions, Mr. Victor has given on-camera interviews in which he discussed facts of the case beyond what was presented in the Complaints and the Amended Complaints. He has spoken about the evidence and the issues in what the City Defendants contend is a misleading and prejudicial manner, including assessing his case as a "slam dunk," characterizing the events of the case as an "outrage," and stating that the City of Phoenix had a "reckless disregard" for public safety. (See Exhibit A, June 2013 News Articles 4-5, and related **Broadcasts** 2, available at at at http://www.abc15.com/dpp/news/region_phoenix_metro/central_phoenix/Baseline-Killercase-Valley-attorney-says-he-has-proof-evidence-went-untested; at 3, available http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=YTbyLkaatXs; at 10, available at http://www.youtube. com/watch?v=N7EOHIptwWI). Mr. Victor has also made multiple personal appearances on radio programs where he provided prejudicial and inaccurate information. During a broadcast of "Declare Your Independence"—freely available online and syndicated through two internet radio networks—Mr. Victor describes male detectives collecting sexual assault evidence from the bodies of living victims, which is demonstrably false and inflammatory. (See Exhibit B, CDs containing Recording of Marc Victor on Declare Your Independence, at Part II, minute 9:40).

Furthermore, the press has printed or disseminated prejudicial and inaccurate information that only could have been obtained from Plaintiffs and/or their counsel. During his appearance on "Declare your Independence, Mr. Victor gave a large 2776523.1

number of documents to the host, Ernest Hancock, who posted them on the website that he controls, Freedom's Phoenix. (See Exhibit B at Part I, minute 35:00, and Exhibit C, at 12-14). More recently, Mr. Victor provided evidence—from his forensic DNA expert report regarding inadmissible legal conclusions and ultimate issues of liability—to two local news stations. For instance, in one nightly news broadcast, a reporter quoted the expert report, which called Defendants' actions a "failure" and "a neglect of due diligence." (See Exhibit A, available at http://www.abc15.com/dpp/news/region_phoenix _metro/central_phoenix/Baseline-Killer-case-Valley-attorney-says-he-has-proof-eviden ce-went-untested; at minutes 1:25 and 3:00). In addition to providing interviews for these reports, Plaintiffs' counsel also reposted the videos of the report to YouTube along with his own prejudicial characterization and commentary on the case. (See Exhibit F, YouTube Account Record).

Additionally, Mr. Victor has aggressively promoted and cross linked articles relating to the case across several websites and social networking services, including his own website, a personal YouTube account, Wordpress blog, Tumblr, Twitter, iPhone app, and Pintrest. (*See* Exhibit D, Social networking and web accounts associated with Mr. Victor). Whenever a story relating to this case was published, Mr. Victor posted a link to it on all of these websites, often along with a prejudicial characterization or emotionally charged language, such as saying the families are seeking "millions" or that the City of Phoenix should have prevented the deaths of family members. Each of these websites have their own individual and extensive audience, and all support further sharing

We both understand the ramifications of challenging the Phoenix Police Department on such a high profile case that will bring out the worst that government has to dish out by people with a monopoly on force, ... in fact, that is why we do it. Few others are willing or able.

and distribution through sites like Facebook, Google Plus and Twitter. Such unabashed promotion ensures that any prejudicial statements made are distributed to as wide an audience as possible, exponentially increasing its potential impact on an unsuspecting jury pool.

Mr. Victor's extensive web presence shows that he is not only willing and able to aggressively involve the media and the public in the details of this case (which are not necessarily admissible), but he has a habit of doing so. (See Exhibit D). Moreover, Mr. Victor has no intention of stopping. When defense counsel contacted Mr. Victor and requested that he refrain from speaking with the media, explaining that the prejudicial effect on potential jurors would be irreparable given the rapidly approaching trial date, he stated that he would stop only if the City Defendants withdrew their Motion for Continuance of the September trial. (See Exhibit E, Correspondence with Victor, at 1-2).

Defendants see no valid basis for the repetitive comments to the media. Instead, such promotion has the effect of disseminating prejudicial statements that have a likelihood of improperly influencing the jury pool. Prejudicial commentaries and the distribution of inadmissible evidence provide misleading and prejudicial information to citizens who could serve as potential jurors in this case, which jeopardizes the Defendants' due process right to a fair trial by an impartial jury. Short of a restraining order, it is anticipated that the media coverage, encouraged by Plaintiffs' counsel, will continue along with the impropriety of trying this case in the court of public opinion.

II. THIS COURT SHOULD EXERCISE ITS INHERENT AUTHORITY TO DEFENDANTS' FUNDAMENTAL RIGHT

The very essence of due process is that a defendant, even in a civil trial, is entitled to a trial by an impartial jury free from outside influences. U.S. Const. Amend. 14; Ariz. Const. art. II, § 23; See Sheppard v. Maxwell, 384 U.S. 353, 362-63 (1969).² The City Defendants have no objection to the news media reporting facts obtained from

the court file or hearings in open court. But with the advances in media technology and access the internet has provided in recent years, trial participants have increasingly attempted to use the media as a strategic tool in conducting a case, often resulting in the dissemination of misleading information or inadmissible evidence. ³ The public has a legitimate interest in the outcome of trials; "the public's legitimate interest, however, precludes distortion of what goes on inside the courtroom, dissemination of matters that do not come before the court, or other trafficking with truth intended to influence proceedings or inevitably calculated to disturb the course of justice." Pennekamp v. Florida, 328 U.S. 331, 361 (1946) (Frankfurter, J., concurring). Therefore, the First Amendment rights of the parties and counsel must be weighed against the defendants' Fourteenth Amendment right to a fair trial before an impartial jury. To ensure that trials are fair, federal and state courts have long recognized the court's inherent authority to control trial participants and attorneys. *Sheppard*, 384 U.S. at 360 (stating that "the judge should have further sought to alleviate this problem by imposing control over the statements made to the news media by counsel"); see also Dow Jones & Co. v. Simon, 842 F.2d 603, 610 (2d Cir. 1988) (applying the "reasonable likelihood" standard that pretrial publicity will prejudice a fair trial), cert. denied, 488 U.S 946 (1988).

In Sheppard, the Supreme Court expressly ruled that a trial court must take strong measures to ensure that a defendant, even in a civil trial, is not prejudiced by unfair news commentary preceding or during a trial:

> From the cases coming here we note that unfair and prejudicial news comment on pending trials has become increasingly prevalent. Due process requires that the accused receive a trial by an impartial jury free from outside pervasiveness influences. Given the of communications and the difficulty of effacing prejudicial publicity from the minds of the jurors, the trial courts must take strong measures to ensure that the balance is never weighed against the accused. And appellate tribunals have the duty to make an independent evaluation of the circumstances. Of course, there is nothing that proscribes the press from

Gentile, 501 U.S. at 1074.

reporting events that transpire in the courtroom. But where there is a reasonable likelihood that prejudicial news prior to trial will prevent a fair trial, the judge should continue the case until the threat abates, or transfer it to another county not so permeated with publicity.

384 U.S. at 362-63. *Sheppard* further recognized that "the trial court might well have proscribed extrajudicial statements by any lawyer, party, witness, or court official which divulged prejudicial matters." *Id.* at 361; *accord Nebraska Press Ass'n v. Stuart*, 427 U.S. 563-64 (1976) (invalidating a gag order against the press but looking favorably on allowing the court to take other measures, including limiting what lawyers and witnesses may say in public).

More recently, the Supreme Court has also upheld a state-disciplinary rule that prohibits counsel from making statements that have a "substantial likelihood of materially prejudicing" an adjudicative proceeding. *Gentile v. State Bar of Nevada*, 501 U.S. 1030 (1991). The Supreme Court noted that attorneys have a fiduciary duty to not obstruct the fair administration of justice, stating:

As officers of the court, court personnel and attorneys have a fiduciary responsibility not to engage in public debate that will redound to the detriment of the accused or that will obstruct the fair administration of justice. Because lawyers have special access to information through discovery and client communications, their extrajudicial statements pose a threat to the fairness of a pending proceeding since lawyers' statements are likely to be received as especially authoritative....We agree with the majority of the States that the 'substantial likelihood of material prejudice' standard constitutes a constitutionally permissible balance between the First Amendment rights of attorneys in pending cases and the states interest in fair trials.

Arizona also has similar ethical rules governing trial publicity. Ethics Rule 3.6 expressly proscribes extrajudicial statements when it is likely to result in prejudice in a pending litigation:

A lawyer who is participating or has participated in the investigation or litigation of a matter shall not make an extrajudicial statement that the lawyer knows or reasonably should know will be disseminated by means of public communication and will have a substantial likelihood of

materially prejudicing an adjudicative proceeding in the matter.

Ariz. R. Sup. Ct 42 E.R. 3.6(a) (2003). Comment 5 to Rule 3.6 explains that certain subjects, such as the expected testimony of a witness or evidence the attorney reasonably knows will be inadmissible, are more likely than not to have a material prejudicial effect on a proceeding, particularly when they relate to a civil matter triable to a jury. *Id*.

Like the lawyer in *Gentile*, Mr. Victor is an officer of the court with the fiduciary duty to avoid obstructing justice. Mr. Victor has made inflammatory and prejudicial statements about the City Defendants and disseminated his DNA expert's improper opinions about legal conclusions and ultimate issues of liability. *See Nationwide Transp. Fin. v. Cass Info. Sys., Inc.*, 523 F.3d 1051, 1058 (9th Cir. 2008) (holding that experts cannot give legal conclusions or their conclusion as to the ultimate issue of law); *Webb v. Omni Block, Inc.*, 216 Ariz. 349, 355, 166 P.3d 140, 146 (App. 2007) (holding that expert testimony that simply tells the jury the level of liability is inadmissible).

Furthermore, steps have been taken to spread these prejudicial statements throughout the public (and the jury pool) by means of internet-social networking. One news broadcast that detailed the content of Plaintiffs' expert report was posted on Mr. Victor's website, Wordpress blog, Twitter, Tumblr, Pintrest, and YouTube account, as well as being accessible from Mr. Victor's personal IPhone app. (*See* Exhibits A-D and F). Not only has Mr. Victor provided evidence and interviews he knew would be disseminated through public communication, he actively assisted in disseminating it, which ensured that it would reach the widest possible audience, many of whom are potential jurors in a trial scheduled just months from now.

Although the media will report what it will, parties to this litigation must refrain from contributing and distributing prejudicial statements. Mr. Victor has insured that his remarks have been widely disseminated through many different channels, from blogs to radio to the television news, and are therefore falling upon the unsuspecting ears of a significant portion of the prospective jury pool. Given the rapidly approaching trial

date and the likelihood that Mr. Victor will further engage with the public and the media, the City Defendants seek a restraining order preventing the parties and attorneys in this case from making extrajudicial statements. Furthermore, Defendants would like to renew their Motion for Continuance in order to ameliorate the damage caused by the recent release of Mr. Victor's expert report and the subsequent media reports. *See Sheppard*, 384 U.S. at 362-63 (finding that where there is a reasonable likelihood that prejudicial news prior to trial will prevent a fair trial, the judge should continue the case until the threat abates).

III. CONCLUSION

Mr. Victor's public commentary on the nature of the evidence, the strength of his case, dissemination of the ultimate and inadmissable opinions of this DNA expert, commentary about undisclosed "detectives" who will support his theory—all within the 90-day-time frame prior to trial—has prejudiced the City Defendants. Therefore, the City Defendants respectfully request that this Court grant a restraining order and a continuance to guarantee their right to a fair trial before an impartial jury.



Baseline Killer case: Valley attorney says he has proof evidence went untested

PHOENIX - As a lawsuit against the City of Phoenix makes its way through the courts, new documents allege the crime lab handling the evidence failed to test critical items.

The documents, obtained by ABC15, were sent to several family members of victims now suing the City of Phoenix for failing to stop Mark Goudeau.

Goudeau, the so-called Baseline Killer, is on death row after being convicted of killing nine people and raping and robbing others during a crime spree in 2005 and 2006.

The new documents were prepared by a DNA expert in Massachusetts for Valley attorney Marc Victor.

Victor represents the families suing the city regarding the handling of evidence.

"It's not frivolous, it's what I would call a slam dunk kind of a case," Victor told ABC15.

Victor hired the DNA expert to analyze the Baseline Killer investigation evidence and handling of the evidence by the Phoenix Police Department crime lab.

In the documents, Forensic DNA Consultant Mary Kate McGilvray said the crime lab "failed" on several occasions, had "reckless disregard" and failed to test the evidence in a timely manner.

The document focuses on the evidence from a rape in a south Phoenix park.

Victor says the lab failed to test two DNA swabs from the victim along with the victim's underwear.

"They take the right breast swab and they order those for testing at the Phoenix crime lab, the left breast swabs are not sent for testing, they're put in the freezer," said Victor.

McGilvray also noted in the documents that Phoenix Police Department detectives had submitted a priority request on all of the evidence, but Victor and McGilvray claim the evidence sat for several months before the additional evidence was tested.

"I believe the detectives did a good job," said Victor. "They got the ball down the field and it just stopped, they (crime lab technicians) simply dropped the ball."

Victor says he believes there was a communication breakdown as well.

"I believe the detectives thought it was all tested, and we believe at this point the detectives were told it was all tested, and then found out and said 'test everything, everything now," said Victor.

According to the report, as the evidence sat in the freezer from the 2005 rape, Goudeau's crimes continued.

"There were actually eight people murdered during that time frame, that would not have been murdered had Mark Goudeau simply been taken into custody," said Victor. "I do have a detective who was very involved in the Baseline Killer investigation who is going to be on our witness list."

Victor says the additional swabs that sat in the freezer were not tested by technicians because an initial swab that was analyzed was difficult for technicians to extract DNA, therefore, the remaining swabs were held.

"They're chasing pot smokers like crazy and testing green leafy substances while serial murderers and serial rapists aren't getting enough attention, this is an outrage, a huge public safety problem," said Victor.

Goudeau's DNA profile was already in the system from a previous felony conviction.

Once lab technicians tested the remaining evidence Victor says, "Bam, match right to Mark Goudeau from that breast swab and the rest is history, they go out and pick up Mark Goudeau, end of case."

The trial between Victor and the City of Phoenix is expected to begin in September.

To be clear, ABC15 contacted the Phoenix Police Department for reaction to this story and the report conducted by Victor's expert, but department officials were unable to comment due to pending litigation.

It is standard procedure for the City of Phoenix Police Department to not comment on pending lawsuits.

McGilvray also noted in the documents that Phoenix Police detectives had submitted a priority request on all of the evidence, but Victor and McGilvray claim the evidence sat for several months before the additional evidence was tested.

"I believe the detectives did a good job," said Victor. "They got the ball down the field and it just stopped, they (crime lab technicians) simply dropped the ball."

Victor says he believes there was a communication breakdown as well.

"I believe the detectives thought it was all tested, and we believe at this point the detectives were told it was all tested, and then found out and said 'test everything, everything now," said Victor.

According to the report, as the evidence sat in the freezer from the 2005 rape, Goudeau's crimes continued.

"There were actually eight people murdered during that time frame, that would not have been murdered had Mark Goudeau simply been taken into custody," said Victor. "I do have a detective who was very involved in the Baseline Killer investigation who is going to be on our witness list."

Victor says the additional swabs that sat in the freezer were not tested by technicians because an initial swab that was analyzed was difficult for technicians to extract DNA, therefore, the remaining swabs were held.

"They're chasing pot smokers like crazy and testing green leafy substances while serial murderers and serial rapists aren't getting enough attention, this is an outrage, a huge public safety problem," said Victor.

Goudeau's DNA profile was already in the system from a previous felony conviction.

Once lab technicians tested the remaining evidence Victor says, "Bam, match right to Mark Goudeau from that breast swab and the rest is history, they go out and pick up Mark Goudeau, end of case."

The trial between Victor and the City of Phoenix is expected to begin in September.

To be clear, ABC15 contacted the Phoenix Police Department for reaction to this story and the report conducted by Victor's expert, but department officials were unable to comment due to pending litigation.

It is standard procedure for the City of Phoenix Police Department to not comment on pending lawsuits.

- This shows both right and left breast swabs with similar numbers but different prefixes. It is possible these items are from another case even though DR 2005 51799055 is stamped at the top.

Looking at Tab 10 and Tab 11, it looks like a request to run the DNA from 3.C.C was made September 5, a fresh buccal swab was submitted on September 7 to confirm a hit, and the report was written on September 11.

- A fresh standard from Mark Goudeau is used to confirm the CODIS hit.

- This apparently shows that Phoenix crime lab reported that the right breast swab was screened, but not the left breast swab. And that no DNA was found.







Baseline Killer: Never should have happened



Subject: Phoenix Baseline Killer

September 20, 2005. Alejandra was raped. So was her sister. They were lucky. Lucky to be left alive.

In the process of the rape, the rapist licked both of her breasts. The Phoenix Police Department arranged for DNA swabs to be taken from both of her breasts, along with <u>other samples collected</u> using a sex (rape) kit. <u>18 samples for testing were eventually produced much later</u>.

The Phoenix Police Dept. had several rapes on their hands with similar characteristics at this point and suspected a serial rapist was at work.

September 22, 2005. (48 hours) Phoenix Police detectives requested the Phoenix Crime Laboratory perform analysis on ALL items in the sex kit. Both the above mentioned left and right breast swabs are in this kit and have been preserved under a chain of custody since their collection.

October 9, 2005. (2 1/2 weeks) The Crime Lab identifies biological material (nucleated cells) present that

would be suitable for DNA testing on both the left AND the right breast swabs, as well as the labia and wlva swabs --- areas where the rapist had also licked.

The right breast swab $\underline{\text{was ordered tested}}$ by the Crime Lab. But inexplicably, the left breast swab was not tested and instead was $\underline{\text{placed in a freezer for storage}}$ untested.

Why some samples were ordered tested and not others is not explained. This was a conscious decision because all other specimens are ordered to be stored instead of tested.

November 23, 2005. (Two months) The right breast swab is finally tested by the Phoenix Crime Lab. The results are marked inconclusive. Inconclusive for non-victim DNA or inconclusive for a sufficient number of distinguishing markers?

The test being performed is referred to as an STR ("star") test, and looks for matching "short tandem repeats."

[adapted from Wikipedia] A short tandem repeat (STR) in DNA occurs when a pattern of two or more nucleotides are repeated AND the repeated sequences are directly adjacent to each other and are repeated a unique number of times per individual.

The STRs in use today for forensic analysis are all tetra- or penta-nucleotide repeats (4 or 5 nucleotides long repeated), as these give a high degree of error-free data while being robust enough to survive degradation in non-ideal conditions.

CODIS (Combined DNA Index System = CODIS, the FBI national DNA forensics database) uses 13 STR markers each located on different human chromosomes, plus AMEL marker which is used to determine the sex of the DNA donor being tested (markers designated):

- * CSF1PO
- * D3S1358
- * D5s818
- * D7s820
- * D8S1179
- * D13s317
- * D16s539 * D18s51
- * D21s11
- * FGA
- * THO1
- * TPOX * WA

The analysis is performed by extracting nuclear DNA from the cells of a forensic sample of interest, then amplifying specific regions of the extracted DNA by means of a polymerase chain reaction. Once these sequences have been amplified, they are resolved through capillary electrophoresis, which will allow the analyst to determine the number of repeats of the STR sequence in question are present.







So what is going on here? Why didn't all of the samples get tested?

Ground was broken on the new <u>Phoenix Police Crime Laboratory</u> in October of 2004. It was completed and open for business in 2005. Clearly their <u>CODIS data for 2004 and 2005</u> are essentially identical so they were working as a testing laboratory somewhere before their new lab was completed. So experience should not be an excuse.

Overworked? Overburdened with samples?

It's mission statement is "The central purpose for the existence of the Phoenix Police Department Crime Laboratory is to provide the highest quality forensic services and scientific technical support to the criminal justice community. Our vision is to make Phoenix the safest major city by providing excellence in forensic science analysis."

From December 12, 2005 through June 26, 2006 (three to nine months) eight people were murdered. It is believed their murderer may be linked to prior rapes that have occurred in the same area under similar circumstances.

During this time on February 16, 2006 (five months) <u>Phoenix Police Detectives request</u> the Phoenix crime lab again test ALL of the biological material from the Alejandra rape case for DNA because of "[t]he magnitude of all the possible related cases and the number of victims...."

March 1, 2006, (5 1/2 months) the Phoenix Crime Lab<u>extracts 18 samples</u> for DNA testing. No results are presented, so were DNA tests done?

August 24, 2006 (11 months) After months of begging and threats detectives within the Phoenix Police Department are finally given permission to request the Arizona Department of Public Safety's (DPS) Forensic Laboratory DNA test all of the Alejandra rape specimens, including both the right and left breast swabs. The request they make is for a more specific y-STR ("why-star") DNA test, is a STR test that is specific for males. But the markers are confined to the single Y chromosome normally only found in males. The advantage in rape cases is obvious...only the rapist's DNA should react as long as the victim is female.

y-STR:: The DPS uses 16 y-STR markers each located on different areas of the human Y-chromosome (male chromosome):

DYS456

DYS389I

DYS390

DYS389II

Because only males have a Y chromosome, female DNA does not interfere with Y chromosomal testing. Unlike STR testing, y-STRs are not unique to each individual. The Y chromosome and therefor, the y-STRs are inherited from their fathers, meaning that all paternally related males will have the same y-STR profile.


The DPS not only runs their y-STR test on the right AND the left breast, but labial and circumoral (surrounding the mouth) samples as well. Their test examines matches at 16 different locations on the Y chromosome. Profile matches are expected to occur no less than 1 in 333 times in the African-American population (such as Mark Goudeau). Not a huge number in random probability, but fairly big.

This produced matches from the right breast and labial samples consistent with Mark Goudeau's on file in the offender database, meaning they could not exclude him at the time. Additionally they picked up the rapist's DNA on the inside and outside of the victim's shirt, and outside her purse that were similarly consistent with Mark Goudaeu.

They also ran the (non-y) STR test as well on the left breast that the Phoenix Crime Lab had not tested. This separate test STR has a hit on the stored left breast sample consistent with the victim, her sister and Marc Goudeau. They also tested the left breast sample with their y-STR test producing a similar match to Mr. Goudeau. The combined odds of a random match existing from both tests is over 360 trillion in the African American population. The previously untested left breast sample nails it. [PS: I have my doubts about this odds claim. I doubt it is much over 1 in a billion and would love to see the statistical calculations.]

Further, Mr. Mark Goudeau's DNA sample was on file and available for comparison at the time of the testing.





Extensive testing <u>report by DPS can be downloaded here</u>. I should note, even here the actual test results are not present.

Why the Phoenix Crime Lab failed to yield conclusive forensic STR results on the right breast is unknown. Degraded sample seems less likely since the DPS successfully created a profile in their y-STR test. It is possible they lost at some point the DNA during sample extraction and concentration or that phenol contamination associated with the extraction process remained behind undetected to contaminate and prevent the test reaction from working. Additionally, the rapist rubbed dirt on Alejandra's breasts in an effort to thwart DNA sampling. Soil contaminates are known to inhibit the STR PCR step unless they are well removed from the DNA. Since the actual test results are not present its failure is impossible to evaluate. In fact, none of the actual test results are available...only a final interpretive result.

But the left breast -- which was positive by both STR and y-STR in the DPS laboratory's hands -- was not tested despite repeated demands by Phoenix Police that all specimens collected be tested as a priority, and compatible biological material was noted as being present for testing by the Phoenix Crime Lab scientists

September 11, 2006 (one week shy of one year of terror the community has been held hostage by a serial killer/rapist) the DPS Forensics Lab reports the DNA test referred to as STR ("star") DNA was an State's DNA Indexing System (SDIS) that feeds into CODIS match to suspect Mark Goudeau with the previously untested, but stored, left breast swabs. [It would be more accurate to say the DNA test did not rule Goudeau out as a suspect. Also note, the actual match data is not present.]

Families of the murder victims are rightfully angry their loved ones were not protected from this serial killer when the evidence linking him to rape victims was already at hand before any killing took place. As to why these samples were not tested by the Phoenix Crime Lab after being requested at least twice to do so, hopefully depositions will bring the reasons out.

An attorney for three of the murder victim's families, <u>Marc Victor</u>, who has brought suit on behalf of these families against the City of Phoenix says he is outraged that the police were hampered in their investigation by the failure to get their evidence tested in a timely and apparently accurate manner by the Phoenix crime lab. And that it is unconscionable that it took so long for the specimens to finally be transfered from the Phoenix Crime Lab for testing at an alternate nearby DPS forensic facility.

Counsel,

It has recently come to our attention, in conjunction with recent media coverage, that there

was September 2009 post on a website where it was relayed that Mr. Victor was representing the Vargas family in a civil suit against the City of Phoenix. Indeed, it appears that this was posted after at least one Notice of Claim was served. In that post, there was a solicitation for any law enforcement or other "professional" involved in the Baseline Killer investigation to come forward and give an interview the confidentiality of which would be "aggressively protected."

The exact text of this post, encouraging contact is as follows: "Marc Victor (www.AttorneyForFreedom.com) is the Attorney representing the Vargas family in the wrongful death case arising out of the Baseline Murders case. Marc is asking that anyone with information related to the Baseline Murders investigation please contact him immediately. Marc is aware most members of law enforcement involved in this case acted honorably and were not complicit with the recklessness, gross negligence and subsequent cover up in this case. Marc would like to confidentially speak with the officers and other professionals involved as soon as possible. Marc will aggressively undertake all efforts to keep the interview completely confidential. Marc can be reached at 480-755-7110 or through email at marc@attorneyforfreedom.com. Thank you for your help in this matter."

Based upon the recent Channel 15 news report, it appears that some unidentified detective may have done so. Yet, no such information was produced in response to Defendants' multiple Interrogatories requesting that Plaintiffs provide the substance and detail of all statements of any City of Phoenix employee or former employee who would offer any testimony that Plaintiffs would seek to utilize as an admission. There are several other discovery requests that seek this type of information as well.

We have serious concerns relative to this website post, media reports, and any non-disclosed interviews that may have taken place. To the extent that there have been any, please identify any current or former City of Phoenix employees that you have interviewed outside the presence of any City of Phoenix counsel relative to the allegations in this case. As you are aware, there are certain categories of employees and certain employees who possess certain types of information who many not be interviewed in this manner due to the ex parte nature of the contact. We also request any written correspondence/emails with any identified individuals as those documents would also be responsive to numerous discovery requests. We are seeking this information for purposes of evaluation of the same and to protect our client's interests. We also request that you do not have any contact with any current City of Phoenix employee, or any former employee falling within the prohibited categories, regarding the allegations of this case unless there is an attorney representing the City present.

Please also be aware that we will address this with the Court if necessary. The civil rules do not contemplate "aggressive confidentiality" of such information and it was requested, several different ways, in interrogatories and requests for production. We also believe that this is information required to be disclosed under Rule 26.1.

We would also request, in light of the fast approaching trial date, that the Plaintiffs and/or

their attorney cease involvement in any news coverage relative to this case. The jury summons, if they have not gone out already, will likely issue shortly.




